ROSEWOOD Care Home is ideally situated for the needs of residents and their visitors, being conveniently close to all major routes near the M3 and M27 motorways and the South Coast, yet quietly located with a wooded area opposite and a garden to the rear. There are local shops in Woolston, a Library and a Church and we are close to the water front where you can enjoy a leisurely stroll.

Residents are those aged over 65 years, with a maximum of 33 at any one time, who need some personal care and attention including service users with dementia. We are not a nursing home but do employ experienced care staff with 24 hour cover 7 days a week.

ROSEWOOD is registered as a care home without nursing and is regularly inspected by the authorities. Our commitment to improving the range and level of services for the service users will continue. We welcome suggestions as to how we can improve still further and have questionnaires available.

Care plans are individual agreed plans of care completed from assessments with the resident and their key worker. Each persons plan includes a description of their preferred daily routine, likes and dislikes, needs, specific dietary requirements and any other information that we need to be aware of. The information gathered includes preferences in respect of how they wish to be addressed, any religious and cultural needs and that the core values are used at all times.

Care plans also include risk assessments, medical needs, G.P. and any community requirements.

Key workers are allocated to each resident and are responsible for monitoring, reviewing and co-ordinating the service users' plan which are updated at least monthly.





Our accommodation comprises of 33 ground floor single bedrooms, all with en-suite facilities.

All rooms are fully furnished but service users are encouraged to bring in small personal items to make the room look and feel more homely.



Service users have a main lounge for their use throughout the day and evening which overlooks the garden and there is also a second lounge with a variety of activities and access to the internet.

The dining area has been designed to make mealtimes an enjoyable social occasion for the service users with tables for four.



Full central heating and carpeting are provided throughout the home which is all ground floor.

The main garden has a large patio and grassed area with seating and umbrellas providing shade on sunny days. There is also a further patio garden to the rear, with seating and garden furniture. A pathway leads around the garden if residents would like a walk.



Meals are prepared with a view to offering a balanced varied and nutritious diet. Special dietary requirements of individual service users are also catered for.



Should a service user prefer to have meals in the privacy of their own room, this can usually be arranged although we do encourage service users to make use of the dining area.

The menu board is written daily so service users can see what is on offer and inform the chef if they require an alternative.



Visitors are always welcome at ROSEWOOD following the service user's wishes on having visitors.

A car park area to the front of the property allows easy transfers between the car and home, there is a ramp leading to the front door for easy access.

Facilities include a laundry service at no extra charge.

Visiting services at competitive rates include a hairdresser, chiropodist, optician and dentist.

Regular entertainment is provided from outside agencies such as Music for Health and 'Interact' who come to the home weekly to provide the residents with arts & crafts, reminiscence, exercises and music as well as in house activities including board games, raffle, bingo and quizzes.

Residents are encouraged to pursue their own interests and hobbies where possible. Regular resident meetings are held so we can ensure we are providing the best quality care.
